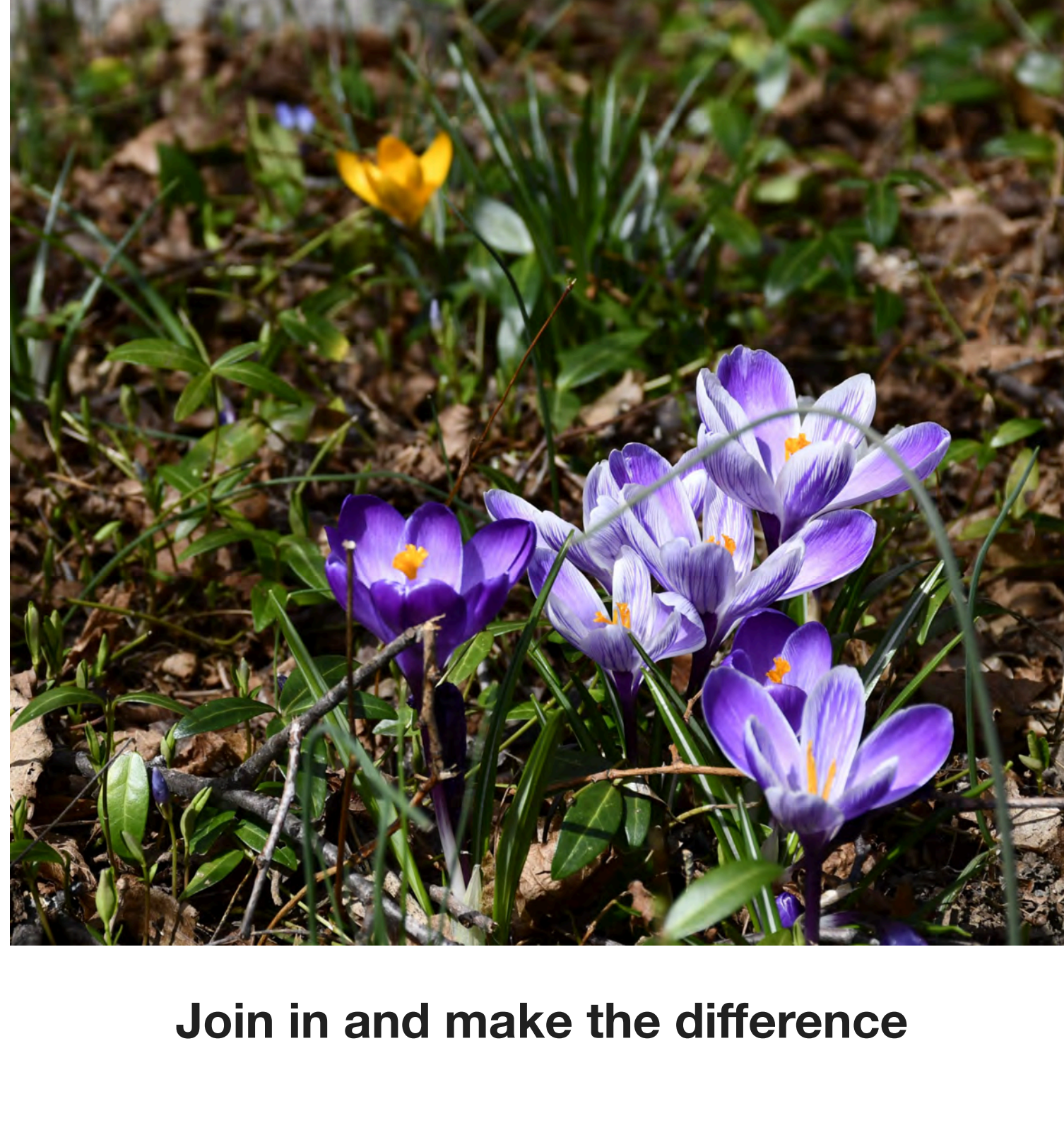


# Yellow Springs March Newsletter

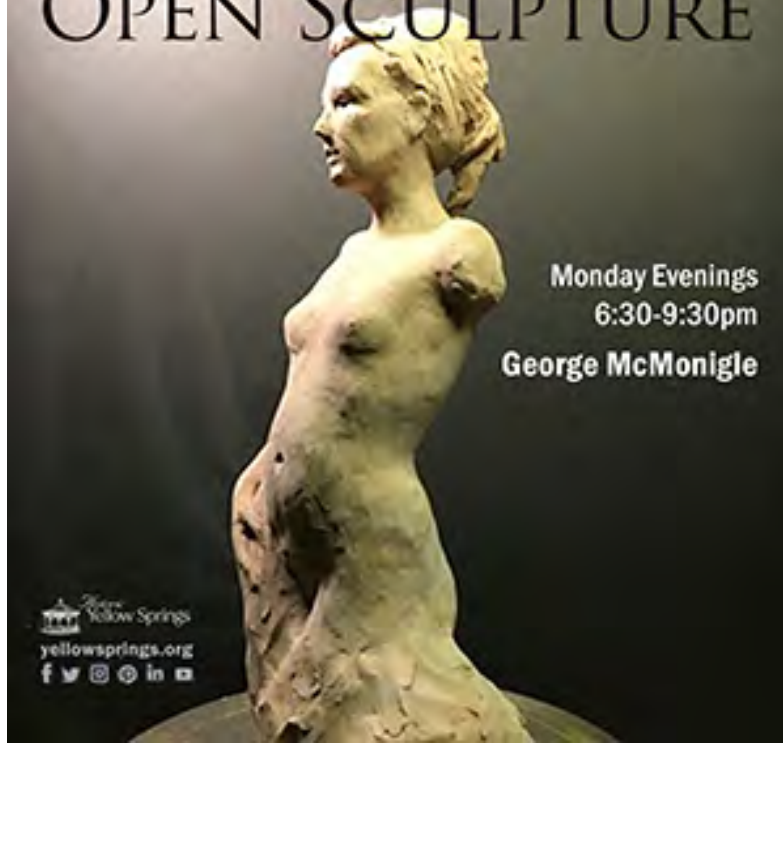

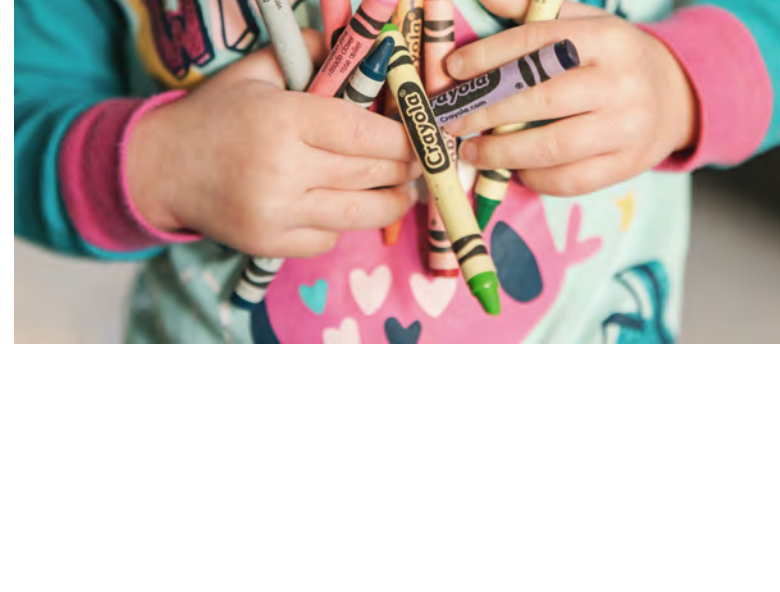

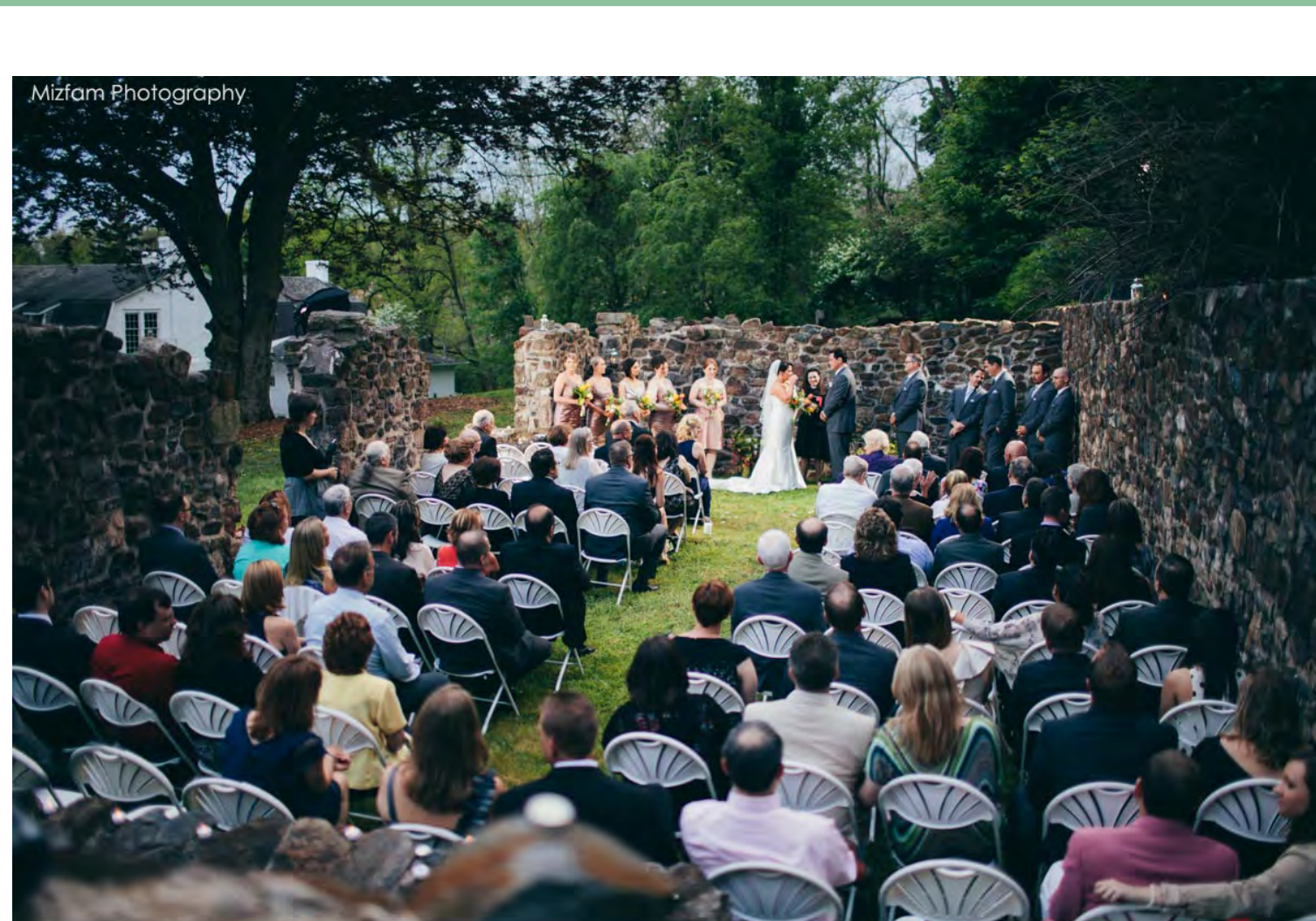
