Materials List

Paper: (brand recommended)

- Strathmore pad drawing paper medium (400 series) 24 sheet – 18 x 24”
- Newsprint pad (rough) 100 Sheet – 18 x 24”

Tools: (brands recommended)

- Willow medium charcoal Winsor & Newton
- Charcoal pencils Medium, Soft, and Extra Soft
- Graphite drawing pencils by any brand: Faber-Castell, General's Kimberly, Design, Derwent or Prismacolor 2B, 4B, and 6B
- “Design” erasers –a kneaded eraser and a hard white eraser
- Artist's Chamois 5” x 7”
- Blending stumps
- Sandpaper paddle (for sharpening charcoal)
- Pencil sharpener

Miscellaneous Equipment

- Measuring device: such as a wooden or metal skewer or straight part of a coat hanger (approx. 6”- 8” long) *be sure to smooth down any rough or pointy tips/edges*
- Clips *(to hold paper to drawing board)*
- A few paper towels
