## **YELLOW SPRINGS' 36<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL ART SHOW: PACKED FULL OF CREATIVE OPPORTUNITIES**

From April 25 through May 10 the public will be able to view and purchase some of the most impressive art exhibited in any area show. This year's show will offer numerous opportunities to emerge in the creative life of the village of Yellow Springs.

Youngsters are invited to participate in *Art Quest for Kids*, a treasure hunt with prizes that will stimulate the participants' observational skills and appreciation for fine art. "Art Quest for Kids" is available throughout the run of the show.

*The Arts of Yellow Springs* is a one-day immersion program for adults on Tuesday May 5 where they will learn the fascinating story of Yellow Springs and its relationship to art. Limited to 20 participants, the day begins with a welcome coffee reception followed by a private early morning tour of the galleries, a complimentary catalog, a guided tour of the Painted Sites Trail, and a box lunch with a showing of a documentary chronicling the Country School, once operated by the Pennsylvania Academy for the Fine Arts at Yellow Springs.

An opportunity to meet and talk with some of the exhibiting artists and site director and a hands-on art workshop with instructors from the Chester Springs Studio will round out the day's experience. The cost for this program is \$40 for members of HYS and \$55 for non-members. ###
