Historic Yellow Springs announced the winner of its 2009 Yellow Springs Art Show poster contest. J. Scott Wolf of Ephrata, PA was selected as the winner. His oil painting “Open Gate” depicts the historic Studio Barn in the village and will be featured in the 2009 Show poster.

Wolf has been painting since he was in high school and studied at the York Academy of Art. His medium of choice is oil after having experimented with watercolors for a short time. He takes much of his inspiration from George Sotter of the New Hope School, which is evident in Wolf’s work. His concentration has always been in the creative arts, combining furniture design with his painting. For the past 15 years, Wolf has exhibited successfully in the Yellow Springs show with his “cloudscapes” in vibrant blues being particular favorites. His paintings have always been a favorite among patrons of the Art Show. Commenting on the Art Show, he mentioned the variety and talent of the artists and the honor he felt in being part of the 36-year tradition. “We are extremely impressed by the quality of the submissions for this juried exhibition,” said Maureen Fendrick, Chair of the 36th Annual Yellow Springs Arts Show, which runs April 25, 2009 to May 10, 2009.
