NEW ARTISTS WELCOMED TO YELLOW SPRINGS ART SHOW

CHESTER SPRINGS, PA – Canadian Artist Makes Yellow Springs Art Show Debut

When the 36th Annual Yellow Springs Art Show opens to the public on April 25 fourteen new artists will be represented. “One of the strongest features of our show is the fresh, vibrant look each year,” said Maureen Fendrick, show chairperson.

Except for one, all the new artists are from the East Coast of the United States and Arizona. The exception will be Marjolyn van der Hart who was born in Holland and is now a resident of the Toronto, Canada area. Her formal art training began at Carleton University in Ottawa, Ontario and continued at Parsons School of Art and Design in New York City and Ringling School of Art and Design in Sarasota, Florida. For the past 4 years she has shown in numerous Art Fairs across the United States including the Bethesda Row Fine Arts Festival in Washington, DC and Rittenhouse Art Festival in Philadelphia, PA. She has also participated in major gallery exhibitions throughout Ontario. Her talent is widely recognized through Best of Show awards, as a lecturer and workshop presenter on both sides of the border.

“This the first time we have welcomed an artist from our neighbor to the north and it signifies how the reputation of the Yellow Springs Art Show has been growing over the years,” Fendrick said. The other new artists comprising the more than 170 exhibitors are from throughout Pennsylvania and Maryland.
